## THE AVIATOR

**Martin Scorsese** directs this biography of eccentric billionaire Howard Hughes, whose obsession with flying...along with his forays into Hollywood from the mid 1920s to the late 1940s are featured in the film. Scorsese's movie includes all the corporate squabbles, industrial innovations, and congressional clashes that made Hughes a legend.

**Leonardo Di Caprio** plays the flying pioneer and is supported by a cast that includes **Cate Blanchett** (as Katherine Hepburn), **Kate Beckinsale**, **Jude Law**, **Gwen Stefani**, **John C. Reilly**, **Alan Alda**, and **Alec Baldwin**. The two-disc set features commentary by Scorsese, a stills gallery, the History Channel documentary *Modern Marvels: Howard Hughes*, deleted scenes, a behind-the-scenes making-of featurette, music featurettes, and more.



### Awards

*The Aviator* won five Academy Awards in 2005: Best Supporting Actress (Blanchett), Cinematography, Art Direction, Film Editing, and Costume Design. The film was also nominated for Best Director (Scorsese), Actor (Di Caprio), Supporting Actor (Alda), Sound, Original Screenplay, and Picture. The movie had the most nominations for the 2005 Awards and also brought home the most statuettes on Oscar night.

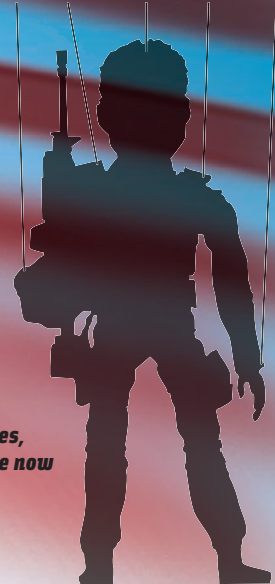


## TEAM AMERICA: WORLD POLICE (UNCENSORED AND UNRATED)

**Trey Parker** and **Matt Stone** (creators of the raunchy *South Park*) strike again with this comedy about the state of world affairs. The marionette-puppet heroes, dubbed Team America, are the protectors of the world—they're ready to fly off at a moment's notice and use their hi-tech weaponry to annihilate the terrorist scum. But the team's real challenge is to defeat mad dictator Kim Jong II, who is bent on acquiring weapons of mass destruction ("it'll be 9/11 times 2356!"). No politically correct convention is unbroken, or sacred cow untouched for that matter, as *Team America* also finds itself at odds with the Film Actor's Guild, which has lampooned several left-leaning, real-life Hollywood personalities (such as **Michael Moore**). Don't be fooled by the puppet characters, though—this movie is full of violence and profanity, so it's absolutely not for younger viewers. *Team America: World Police* is also available in a tamer R-rated version.

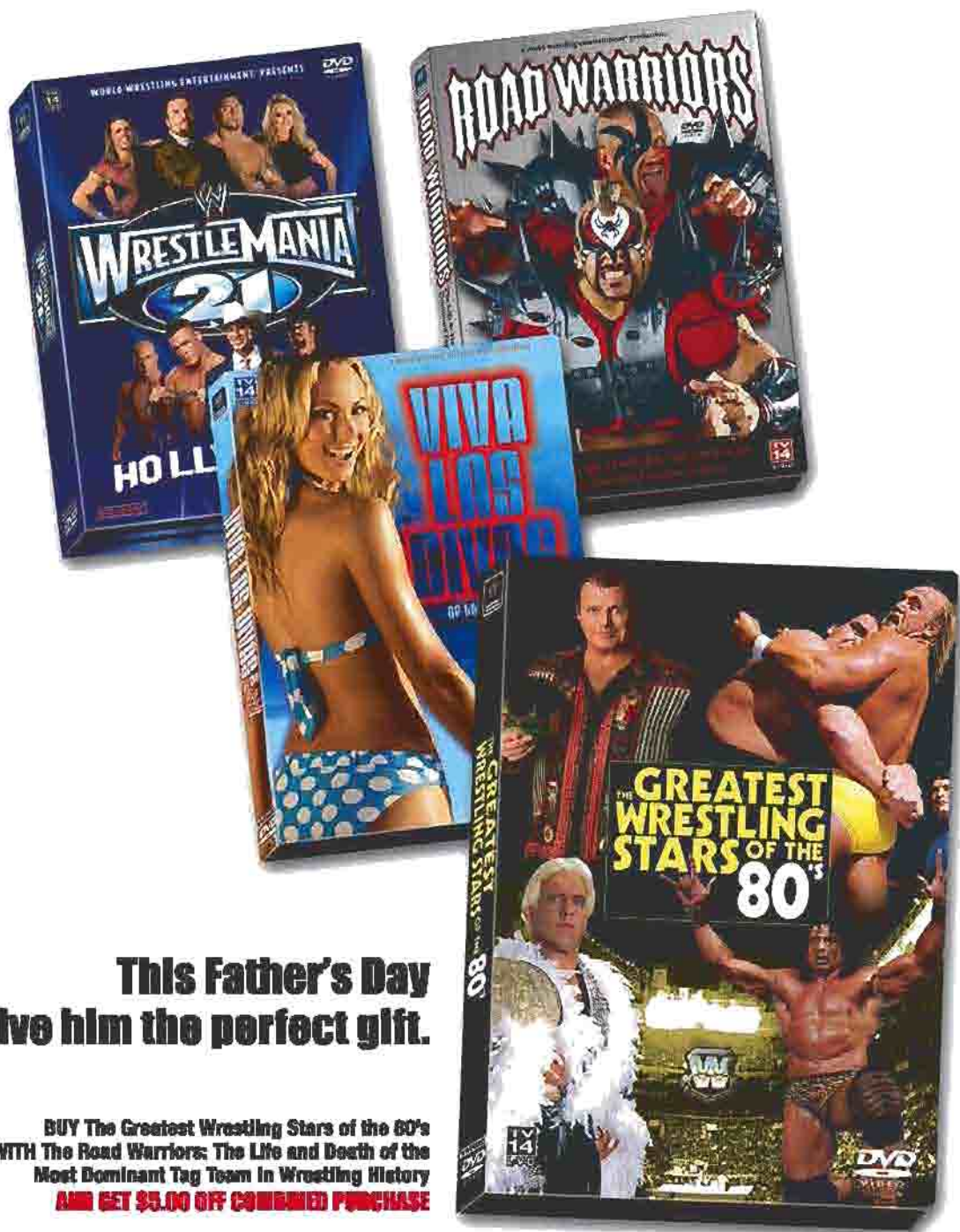

## ARE WE THERE YET?

Rapper-turned-actor **Ice Cube** once again demonstrates his chops for light comedy (*Friday*, *Barbershop*). As Nick Persons, a 30-something player who runs a sports-collectibles store with pal Marty (**Jay Mohr**), he decides to pursue an attraction to Suzanne (**Nia Long**), who has two kids (**Aleisha Allen** and **Phillip Bolden**). They are intensely determined to keep their mom single (and Persons doesn't dig kids), which sets up the meat of the film: Persons and the kids on a manic 24-hour road trip from Portland to Vancouver. The disc offers a good mixture of extras, too, including audio commentary by director **Brian Levant**, a behind-the-scenes short *A Tour of Nick's Fine Sports Collectibles*, a making-of featurette, deleted scenes, outtakes, and even interactive games.



## Road Rage

If you think Ice Cube and his Lincoln Navigator take a lickin', then you ain't seen nothin' until you've checked out these road-trip flicks.

*Easy Rider*: **Peter Fonda** starred in this great road film that defined the end of the 1960s with **Dennis Hopper** and **Jack Nicholson** as his costars.

*Bonnie and Clyde*: This true-to-life gangster trip pic ignited **Faye Dunaway's** career but stars **Warren Beatty** at his best.

*Thelma & Louise*: **Susan Sarandon** and **Geena Davis** drove chick flicks and buddy films right over the genre cliff.

*National Lampoon's Vacation*: Route 66 was never the same after **Chevy Chase** and **Beverly D'Angelo** got through with it. (And keep an eye open for **Christie Brinkley** at her freshest and sexiest.)

*Stranger Than Paradise*: **Jim Jarmusch** didn't miss an exit when he directed this odd and quirky black-and-white road film.

*Coach Carter* tells the tale of Ken Carter (**Samuel L. Jackson**), head coach of Richmond High School (in Richmond, California) from 1997–2002, and his then-momentous decision to lock out his undefeated varsity basketball team in order to push them to improve their grades and otherwise pull their lives together. Carter was prepared to cancel the entire season because 15 of the 45 players were not living up to the academic standards they agreed to at the beginning of the season. DVD extras include deleted scenes, featurettes *Coach Carter: The Man Behind the Movie* and *Fast Break at Richmond High*, and the music video for "Twista," featuring Faith Evans.

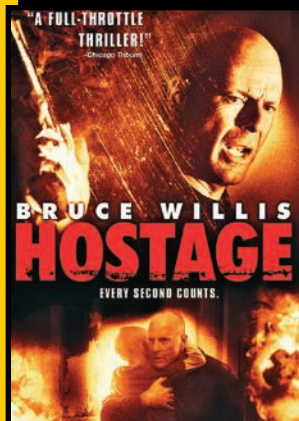

This movie is a question of who's threatening whom as former hostage negotiator Jeff Talley (**Bruce Willis**), who is trying to forget his failure to save a child from a suicidal madman, finds himself thrust back into that role when gunmen abduct a numbers runner (**Kevin Pollack**), whose mobster boss then abducts Talley's family to force him to rescue the runner and recover some incriminating evidence. Got it? If you don't, don't worry because unbeknownst to everyone, there's a psycho killer (**Ben Foster**) in the group who desires to murder them all. 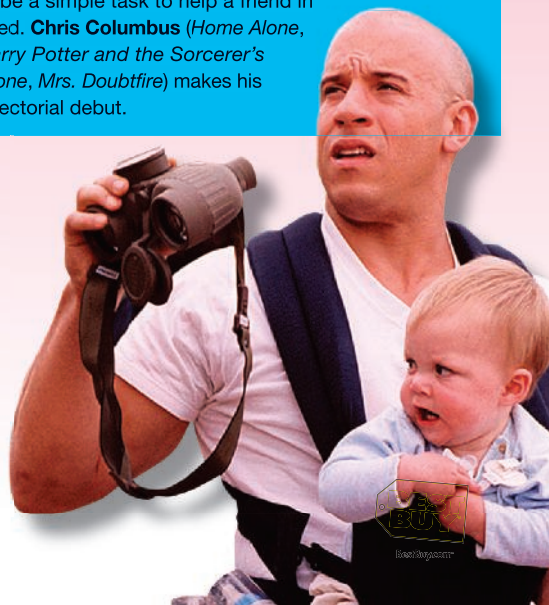


## THE PACIFIER

Diesel predictably uses military training and tactics to tackle child-rearing issues, such as teenage angst, a wacky nanny (**Carol Kane**), and running a Girl Scouts troop.
